

# Balmy Beach Paddlers Capture Own Regatta; Island Club Is Second

Balmy Beach did it again. Beach paddlers took top honors for the fourth consecutive meet Saturday when they piled up 64 points to win their own annual regatta. As has been the way all season, second place went to the Island Club with 19 points. Toronto Sailing and Canoe Club was third with four and Boulevard Club fourth with one point.

With Norm Lane at the Olympics, his brother Ken kept up the family tradition by winning a close race in the senior singles from Hodgson

of the Island Club. Bill Williamson, another Beach entry, started well but rounded the wrong buoy at the half-way mark and was disqualified, leaving Lane and Hodgson to battle down the stretch. Ken, with his slow, steady stroke, crossed the finish line the winner by a length and a half.

The juvenile single was the closest race of the afternoon. George Bedard of the Island Club, who captured firsts in four events at the Island last week, was the favorite, and coming down the stretch looked to be an easy winner. Then Ralph Johnson, another Island boy, came shooting up on the outside to win by several feet.

Bill Williamson and Jesse Blood showed good sportsmanship in the double-blade tandem race when they stopped 10 feet from the finish line so that their clubmates, Mel Homans and Norm Ward, would not commit an unintentional foul. Blood's boat had a slight lead when Homans and Ward veered toward them. Williamson and Blood immediately began to back water, allowing the other craft to clear them by inches and to cross the line the winners.
