

# Beach Paddlers Are Regatta Winners

After failing to win three regattas this season, Balmy Beach Canoe Club paddlers returned to their own waters Saturday afternoon and scored a six-point aggregate victory.

The Canadian Canoe Association co-champions totalled 53 points to 47 by Island Canoe Club, and 42



by the recently successful Toronto Sailing and Canoe Club. It was a typical Beach regatta from the elements standpoint, with a strong Lake Ontario chop capsizing many boats, especially in the early afternoon. Later, the waters became calmer, but not before they had given lifeguards a busy afternoon of fishing out athletes.

Many Beach graybeards called the mile war canoe event, which Beach won, one of the best paddling races they had seen. It was a close one between Jim Mossman's BBCC crew and Pete Connelly's TS&CC collection, with the Torontos holding a length lead at the half. Then the TS&CC crew put on its closing sprint a little early. Beach poured it on with perhaps 300 yards to go and won by a third of a length.

Lloyd Rice, the TS&CC husky, was a triple winner. One of several athletes who have been doing much to raise the points totals of the Torontos this season, Rice took the senior single and double-blade singles and helped to win the senior tandem.

The regatta served as a final tune-up for the CCA Western Division trials at Long Pond, Centre Island, next week. Placers will qualify for the Canadian championship: on Mooney's Bay, near Ottawa.
