

Balmy Beach Blades Score Nine Victories To Win Own Burgee

Balmy Beach Canoe Club paddlers came through Saturday with nine victories and collected 108 points to win the burgee at their own annual regatta on the open-water course at Balmy Beach.

It was Beaches' second regatta win in the Western Division series of five in the local area. Mississauga CC, of Port Credit, had also won two and Toronto Sailing and Canoe Club the other.

Torontos earned 89 points and won five events Saturday, for second place; Mississauga won

three races and counted 73 points; West Rouge CC gained 22 points; Mohawk CC, of Burlington, 16.

The five clubs will compete next Saturday at Long Pond, Centre Island, in the Western Division trials. First three finishers in each of 17 races will qualify to go to Ottawa the following week for the Canadian Canoe Association championships.

Phil Redwood carried over into his first junior year the complete domination he enjoyed in juvenile ranks in the canoe singles. This season, he won the event at all five club regattas, plus the Dominion Day meet. That day, he edged Tom Jamieson of Mississauga.

Jamieson won the senior event the following week and again Saturday, beating veteran clubmate Bill Collins.

An upset was recorded in bantam ranks, even though Saturday marked the close of that class's first complete season. John Mackeracher piloted a West Rouge crew to victory in the canoe fours, edging Harold Heine's boat for the first time this season.

Heine, however, continued his mastery of the singles event and, with Adrian Taylor, in the canoe tandems, which they had won at three previous Western Division regattas.

Season totals show Beaches with 32 victories in the 85 races (17 per regatta). Torontos won 26, Mississauga, in its third year of competition the most improved club in the division, took 25 and West Rouge two. Mohawk was winless in the point-scoring senior, junior and juvenile classes but its bantam blademen promise to get the green and white colors out front within the next few years.

Beaches also were tops in total points, with 493, Torontos (429), Mississauga (412), West Rouge (99) and Mohawk (74) followed.
