3. Pan American Competitions: Cienfuegos, Cuba September 8-12 Thirty-six (36) persons travelled to Cuba: 28 paddlers, 3 coaches, 1 manager and 3 officials.

In the senior competitions, our Ladies team managed to win all three races: Alison Brown, Nancy Olmsted, Lauren Hoyle and Mary Mullen taking the K-4, Brown and Olmsted, the K-2 and Hoyle the K-1. The Senior Men had to settle for silver and bronze medals at best, coming up against a strong Cuban team in both single and double blade events. The Junior men were also outpaddled by the Cubans, managing only one second and 5 thirds. The Junior Ladies won all three events: Nancy Olmsted taking K-1, teaming with Carolyn Carbonneau in K-2, and the two of them with Kim Burns and Jennifer Henry to take the K-4.
