

# Juvenile Paddlers Help Boost Balmy Beachers To Regatta Victory

With a large boost from their juvenile paddlers, Balmy Beach Canoe Club churned to yet another regatta win, in their own annual meet on the open water of Lake Ontario at the foot of Beech Ave. Saturday. The hosts picked up 30 points by sweeping all the scoring points in the four juvenile races to outscore Toronto Sailing and Canoe Club, 59-47. Island Canoe Club earned 22 points. Beach and TS&CC each won seven of the 17 events, Island the other three.

Officials of the Beach Club picked Joan London, tall, tanned and attractive 18-year-old production clerk of 105 Prairie Dr. as Miss Balmy Beach. She will represent the Ontario Rugby Football senior club in the Miss Grey Cup competition in November. Gwen Wilson was awarded second place and Warna Faulkner third.

In contrast to last week, when Beach compiled more points than the combined total of their two opponents, the hosts didn't sag away Saturday's burgee until after the 15th race. TS&CC outscored the east enders in both the senior and junior events, winning three senior and four junior races to Beach's two and one, respectively.

All three of the Island wins were in senior competition, and the club's commodore, Bill White, had a hand—or a paddle—in each. He won the canoe singles, teamed with Frank Sullivan to make the canoe tandems and skipped the boat containing Gus Lamantia, Paul Lambert and Sullivan that won the canoe fours. Lloyd Rice and Atis Bredovskis of TS&CC once more dominated the senior kayak races. They crewed with the LaFlair brothers, John and Pete, to win the fours, paired to take the tandems, and Rice captured the singles. The only competition for the Red and Black in the fours, a Beech crew, disqualified themselves by interfering in Toronto's water. The LaFlairs also won the junior kayak tandem and were one-two (John-Pete) in junior kayak singles.

Jimmy Mossman ran to 10 the string of war canoe boats he has steered to victory when Beach won both the half-mile and mile races.

Ron Hoover and Ron Adams again led in the Beach juvenile sweep. It was Hoover-Adams at the finish of the canoe singles; Hoover and Adams in the winning canoe tandem boat and Al Jones, Mike Russell, Hoover and Adams who beat out Phil Redwood's Beach canoe fours second placers.

Redwood and Neil Bingham, 12 and 14 respectively, staged the most exciting race of the day in the canoe tandems for novices, for which no points were given, they nipped Jones and Russell by a boat nose at the finish. The youngsters came right back in the next race to take a third behind Jones and Russell in the juvenile canoe tandems. Mark Butler of Island won another no-points event, the novice canoe singles.

Island also won both of the supplementary races involving girls. Gail Johnson teamed with Bill Collins for a first in the mixed canoe tandems. Gerry Collins piloted 14 young ladies to a win over Beach's Bill Dennis and a bevy of east end maidens.
