

# Balmly Beach Scores Third Win of Season, Despite Rough Water

Choppy waters off the eastern beaches slowed, but did not stop, Balmly Beach Canoe Club paddlers Saturday. The Blue and Gold blademen churned to their third win in four local regattas with a convincing 114-94 edge over their top rivals, Toronto Sailing and Canoe Club, in the Beachers' annual meet. Island Canoe Club compiled 33 points for third spot. The rookie Mississauga Canoe Club moved out of last place for the first time this season and came extremely close to winning their first race. They earned nine points to three for West Rouge Canoe Club.

Beach won eight of the 18 races, TS&CC took seven and Island the other three.

A dozen boats foundered in the rough swells piled up by a steady southwest wind off the open lake. Some were able to right themselves and finish to earn points, but a couple of scheduled midget boy's races for lads between 8 and 12 years, were cancelled because of the rough going. Crowning indignity

came for Beach when two of their boats sank in front of their own club house in the junior war canoe race. Don May's boat, from TS&CC, strangely enough, seemed to have no trouble at all and coasted to a steady win.
