Beach Paddlers Capture Meet At Port Credit

Balmy Beach Canoe Club won its fourth burgee in as many Western Division regattas when the Blue and Gold paddlers took a narrow decision at the annual meet of Port Credit's Mississauga CC Saturday. Beach compiled 84 points, to 75 by Toronto Sailing and Canoe Club and 74 by the host club. Jim Mossman's victory in the open war canoe, last event on the card, decided the issue, with points for the race on a 12-6-4 basis.

West Rouge CC was fourth with 40 points and Mohawk CC of Burlington gained 29 points. Mossman, an almost perpetual winner of this traditional closing event to all regattas, had been beaten by Mississauga's Frank Garner at Sudbury the Saturday previous.
