

Mississauga wins easily in weekend canoe races

Mississauga Canoe Club won another paddling regatta during the weekend, this time the West Rouge Canoe Club competition, cut to 25 from 38 events because of rough water on Lake Ontario. Mississauga's 203 points easily outdistanced the Island Canoe Club's 80 points. Balmy Beach was third with 67 followed by West Rouge with 42, Mohawk with 39, Oakville with eight and North Bay with just three points.

Lauren Hoyle had three wins and a second-place finish, to pace the Mississauga women paddlers. Kevin Stott was even better for the Mississauga men, with six firsts and one second. Both

paddlers are preparing for the Canadian championships this summer in Montreal.
