1. Dartmouth Regatta

There was an effort made in 1982 to provide more competition for our Development Athletes. The Dartmouth International Regatta provided an excellent opportunity for our developing athletes to compete amongst themselves and against a U.S. team. 3. Pan American Competitions: Cienfuegos, Cuba September 8-12

Thirty-six (36) persons travelled to Cuba: 28 paddlers, 3 coaches, 1 manager and 3 officials.

In the senior competitions, our Ladies team managed to win all three races: Alison Brown, Nancy Olmsted, Lauren Hoyle and Mary Mullen taking the K-4, Brown and Olmsted, the K-2 and Hoyle the K-1. The Senior Men had to settle for silver and bronze medals at best, coming up against a strong Cuban team in both single and double blade events. The Junior men were also out-paddled by the Cubans, managing only one second and 5 thirds. The Junior Ladies won all three events: Nancy Olmsted taking K-1, teaming with Carolyn Carbonneau in K-2, and the two of them with Kim Burns and Jennifer Henry to take the K-4. Clearly
